


**Year 3/4 Curriculum  
Newsletter  
Spring Term 3**

Dear Parents and Carers,

Please have a look over our class curriculum for the coming half term...



**English:**

The topic this term is Vikings. The children will be focusing their writing around play scripts and Norse legends. We will be learning about the layout and features of a script and working towards writing our own. Our reading will focus on a comic book about Thor and Loki.

**Maths:**

This term will continue our learning about multiplication and division, before going to length, perimeter and area. Within this the children will continue to practice their understanding and mastery of multiplication and division, as well as building on prior learning about shapes.

**Science**

The topic this term is light. The children will be learning about how we use light to see and how shadows are the blockage of light. We will also learn about reflections, how shadows change depending on position of the light source, and how light can be harmful to the human eye.

**Theme:**

This term's theme title is *Viking Britain*. The children will be learning about Viking invasions and their life in the UK. A Trip to Canterbury Museum to look at artefacts has also been planned.

**PE & Games:**

The children will be developing their gymnastic skills this term. They will be focusing on jumping and landing and developing a routine.

**RE:**

This term the children will be learning more about Christianity. They will be focussing on the big question: *What kind of world does Jesus want?* In this topic, the children will look at Jesus calling to his disciples and being a fisher of people, as well as Jesus as a healer. The children will think about the meaning of Gospel and how they are important to some Christians.

**Computing:**

Computing this term will require the children to learn how to use word, publisher, and PowerPoint to create posters, fact files and more.

**French:**

The children will continue to learn basic French phrases for conversational use and learn the days of the week and months of the year. They will also learn songs in French.
